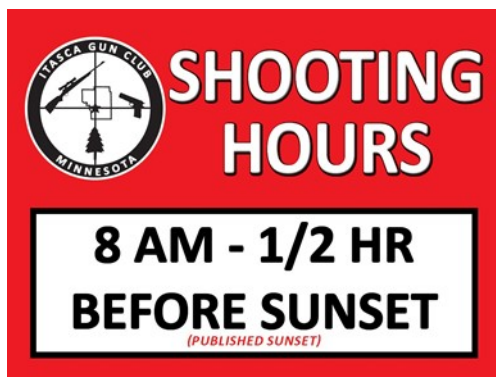


Welcome To The Itasca Gun Club

BASIC FIREARM SAFETY RULES

ALWAYS KEEP FIREARMS POINTED IN A SAFE DIRECTION

ALWAYS KEEP THE ACTION OPEN AND FIREARM UNLOADED UNTIL READY TO USE

ALWAYS KEEP YOUR FINGER OFF THE TRIGGER AND OUTSIDE THE TRIGGER GUARD UNTIL READY TO SHOOT

KNOW YOUR TARGET AND WHAT IS BEYOND

BE SURE YOUR FIREARM IS SAFE TO OPERATE

KNOW HOW TO USE YOUR FIREARM SAFELY

USE ONLY THE CORRECT AMMUNITION FOR YOUR FIREARM

WEAR HEARING AND EYE PROTECTION

NEVER USE ALCOHOL OR DRUGS BEFORE OR WHILE SHOOTING

STORE FIREARM SO IT IS NOT ACCESSIBLE TO UNAUTHORIZED PERSONS

RANGE RULES

Members shall have a current paid up membership card with them while at the range to show at any time if requested.

All vehicles must stay on the access road when going down to the target area. Drive down to your target line, then walk to your targets.

Itasca Gun Club is a rifle and pistol club. Grand Rapids Gun Club is your option for trap and skeet.

IGC is an alcohol free range. Avoid smoking near other people and on the firing lines

Tannerite or other explosive targets are not allowed on this range due to insurance and litter issues.

Only shoot at targets. Hitting rocks can easily send ricochets far outside the range into populated areas. Shooting at target frames or supports forces club volunteers to repair those.

Each member shall clean up their area including picking up brass and taking their targets down.
